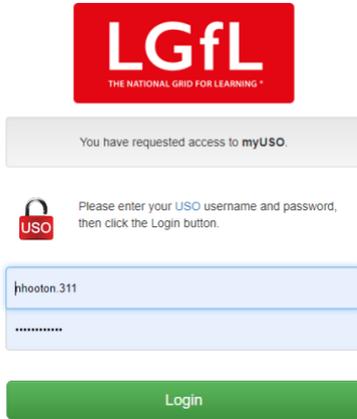




Summer Online Activities at St. Alban's Guide to LGFL J2E5



LGFL APPs: J2E5 London Grid for Learning provides a wealth of resources. One of the most feature-rich is J2E5. This allows children to create their own pages of text, pictures or mixed content. These pages can be readily linked to create mini (or not so mini) websites.



First, log in to LGFL by clicking on the logo on the Home Learning page.

(Your LGFL logins were issued on a strip of paper; all of these will be **your child's initial** then **last name**, then maybe **some numbers** followed by **.311**.)

PLEASE LOOK CAREFULLY: THE '1' AND THE 'L' LOOK VERY SIMILAR, e.g. Brenda Small could be bsmall12.311)

If you are asked to agree to the service, this is fine for you to do so.

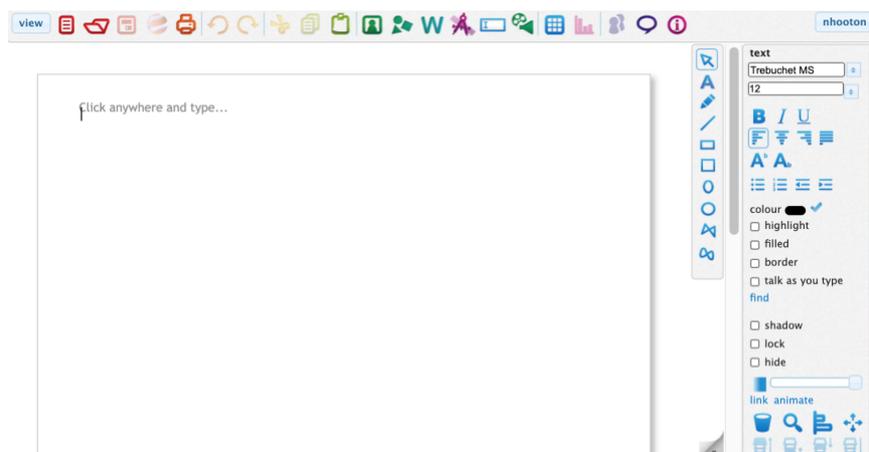
Next, click on '**Resources**' then '**Library**' on the left-hand side of the page. You should then see a grid like the one below. You can either scroll down to find 'J2Ee' or type it in the '**Search**' box on the top right of the page.

You are looking for the tile below:



Click on it to enter the mini-site. You will see the screen below:

The best place to start is 'J2E5' This is a fully-featured publishing tool.



If you [follow this link](#), you can watch a video explaining how to get the most out of this tool. All work is saved on your child's account and can be accessed by clicking on 'my files.'

If your child is at foundation or Key Stage 1 age, then **JIT** is a simple collection of online tools that will allow them to creatively produce attractive content with the help of word-banks and picture stamps.



If your child is at foundation or Key Stage 2 age, then using the set of tools in **j2Office** could sit them well. With a very similar look and with similar tools to MS Office, all of their work can be stored, edited and completed in their own time. Work can also be imported and exported into 'Word' and other Office Apps



J2Camera even allows your child to take photos of themselves and apply effects before storing them in their file area to include in other documents like J2E or JIT.



All-in-all, **J2E** is a comprehensive package of tools that could keep your child creatively occupied for weeks!
